- Participants may enter the 50m race if they are not entering any races 100m or longer.
- In the running long jump, an athlete must be able to jump at least 1 meter.
- An athlete cannot enter both the running and the standing long jump
- The minimum opening height for the National high jump competitions shall be 1 meter for all divisions.
- We will be operating open pits for the field events. Athletes should plan their participation in the field events around their track events. Athletes will be placed into groups of no more than 5 athletes. Shot put preliminaries must be completed in the morning and the finals in the afternoon.
- The 4x100M relay is a fun event. Registration for the relays will occur on the day of the event. Relay teams must be made from the same club. Co-ed teams are not permitted as per the rules.

Lunch

- Lunch for teams will be distributed by team. One or two team representatives are asked to pick up the lunch for their team.
- Coach lunches will be supplied at a ratio of 1 coach for every 4 athletes. Any additional lunches for coaches are \$8 each
- Parents can pre-order lunches through the team at \$8 each. These lunches will be distributed with the team order.
- There is no opportunity to purchase lunches on the day of the event. There is a Tim Horton's across the street from the school.
- Please provide the lunch order when submitting the team entry.

Results

- Results for events with preliminaries will be provided to the head coaches during lunch.
- The Maximum Performance Rule Policy 7000-208 will be applied for events with a preliminary round. The athlete will not be penalized for MPR infractions and will receive ranking points for the placement achieved in the new division.

Entry Fee

- Entry Fee is \$25 per athlete. Cheques should be made out to Special Olympics Brantford. Invoices will be sent to the teams before the event.

Entry Deadlines

- Entry Deadline is Wednesday, June 26th, 2024. Minor changes can be accommodated after that date, but the main team entry must be submitted.
- Additional athletes must be added by Tuesday, July 2nd, 2024.
- Modifications to events for athletes can be accommodated up to Tuesday, July 2nd, 2024.
- As per the technical package - There will be no changes to event entries once the competition has started. Scratches will be considered a DNS and the athlete will receive zero points toward their ranking
