**Each team guaranteed 4 games.** Tournament will have 4 D Teams and 4 D (Rec) Teams.

- Each game will be two 12-minute halves. At half time, there will be a 2-minute stop in time.
- Each team will be allowed one 30-second time-out per half.
- NO formal lunch break. It will be the responsibility of each team to have their lunch while on a game break, between 11:30AM – 1:00PM. Lunch and drinks are supplied.
- For the championship game, if there are ties, the finalist will be decided by the winner of the game between the 2 teams tied. If more than 2 teams are tied, we will use the game winner rule above and if necessary, we will use most points scored in round robin to decide the finalists.
- There is NO smoking on the property – monitors will be available to assist players who wish to leave the property to smoke.
- Lunch tickets will be distributed for all athletes/coaches upon registration. Additional food will be available for parents/spectators by free will donation. Athletes play for one team only (D OR D-Rec, not both). Please take care to ensure your team reflects the tournament competition level. Blowout rule in effect, a 25-point differential will lead to 50/50 points split.
