- 4. All Special Olympics Ontario coaches and volunteers will conduct themselves in accordance to the Coach/Volunteer Code of Conduct.
- 5. Any Special Olympics Ontario member who violates the Special Olympics Ontario Code of Conduct shall be subject to disciplinary action outlined in their respective athlete / coach Code of Conduct.
